- 1. 2 hoods, very good shape, one has a slight dent in the nose.
- 2. XR7 right door. You can tell because of the door panel.
- 3. Three stainless wheel moldings need to be reconditioned.
- 4. 1 RH Fender and one other RH fender with 6.5 Liter logo attached
- 5. 2 rear bumpers, straight
- 6. 3 front bumpers, straight
- 7. 4 lower valances for front end with parking lights, slight damage on them but easily repaired
- 8. 3 complete front grills with vacuum reservoirs, and 1 RH half of a grill.
- 9. 1 sequential light box. Unknown of its operability.
- 10. 1 pair of rear lights
- 11. 1 ignition switch, no key.
- 12. 1 pair of front R&L brake drums and shoes. He converted his Cougar to disc brakes.
- 13. 1 rear decklid with XR7 badge. Good condition, no dents.
- 14. 1 hood latch assembly. This is what is between the grills.
- 15. 1 front headlight ballast.


