- 1. 2 hoods, very good shape, one has a slight dent in the nose.
- 2. XR7 right door. You can tell because of the door panel.
- Three stainless wheel mouldings, need to be reconditioned.
 1 RH Fender and one other RH fender with 6.5 Liter logo attached
- 5. 2 rear bumpers, straight
- 6. 3 front bumpers, straight
- 7. 4 lower valances for front end with parking lights, slight damage on them but easily repaired
- 8. 3 complete front grills with vacuum reserviors, and 1 RH half of a grill.
- 9. 1 sequential lite box. Unknown of its operability.
- 10. 1 pair of rear lights
- 11. 1['] ignition swith, no key.
- 12. 1 pair of front R&L brake drums and shoes. He converted his Cougar to disc brakes.
- 13. 1 rear decklid with XR7 badge. Good condition, no dents.
- 14. 1 hood latch assembly. this is what is between the grills.
- 15. 1 front headlight ballast.

I ordered the video from Hanlon Motorsports on how to rebuild a T5. When I inspected what I had, I found the cluster/gear set was not good. I ordered a 2.95 set, 3-4 fork, rebuild kit, clutch cable (the end was frayed), and a King Cobra clutch kit. I also spied the 3.55 gears (I had 3.08) that a friend had given me a long time ago. I ended up getting new tools, too! R_R_R! I picked up a parts washer and a 12-ton shop press. One Saturday morning, Mark Dorner, Gary Workman and his friend John came over to help swap gears. The next day, the car was pulling out at lunchtime for a test drive. I have been driving it ever since. So, if ya want help with rebuilding a T5...
